

Proceedings of Myerstown, Pa. Borough Council as recorded by minutes.

Myerstown, Pa. March 22, 1912

The members of the Borough Council met in the Directors room in the High School Building for the purpose of effecting an organization of Council and transacting such other business as might be brought before it.

All members were present. After all members of Council were sworn into office by the Chief Burgess, Dr. Bower, Council proceeded to the election of a President. Upon motion of Mr. Joseph Painter seconded by Mr. John Donges, Mr. Henry Corl was unanimously elected President. Upon motion S. P. Beekey was elected Secretary of the meeting. It was next suggested that a Borough Solicitor be elected. Upon motion of Mr. Donges seconded by Mr. Painter, Mr. H.A. Honker was unanimously elected Borough Solicitor, salary to be fixed later. Upon motion it was agreed that the office of Secretary and Treasurer should be kept separate. Mr. Ed. Noll was nominated for Secretary. Nominations were closed and upon motion Mr. Noll was unanimously elected Secretary for a term of two years, term expiring Jan, 1914. Nominations were opened for Treasurer. Mr. Frank B. Urich and Mr. Geo Umberger were nominated. Upon ballot Mr. Urich received five votes and Mr. Umberger two. Mr. Urich was declared elected Treasurer of the Borough for a term of two years, term expiring Jan, 1914. Upon motion Council adjourned to meet on Friday evening March 29th at 7:30 P.M. in the High School Building.
