

Proceedings of Myerstown, Pa. Borough Council as recorded by minutes.

Myerstown, Pa. May 3, 1912

The Myerstown Borough Council was called to order by the President H. L. Corl. The roll was called and the following responded. Jno. A. Donges, Jos. M. Painter, Jas. Kalbach, Isaac B. Haak and H. L. Corl. M. C. Haak came later on. The minutes of the previous meeting were read and approved as corrected. Under report of committees Mr. I. B. Haak reported the temporary finance committee secured a loan of \$500 for a period of sixty (60) days at 5 per cent from the Independent Order of Old Fellows #358. Upon motion the report of the committee was received. The road committee reported their action of past week and suggested that pipes be secured for bridges and crossings. Upon motion the report was received. Upon motion the road committee was instructed to proceed to make the necessary repairs. Upon motion the report of the Secretary of the purchase of record books for the different officers was received and orders instructed to be drawn for payment of the source.

An ordinance was presented by Mr. I. B. Haak forbidding the burning of paper, etc; the depositing of ashes, etc; and the throwing of circulars, etc; on the streets, etc; and the posting of signs, etc, and the writing on sidewalks, etc, etc. Upon motion the ordinance presented was laid on the table until next meeting. A motion by Mr. Painter seconded by Mr. I. B. Haak that the Street Committee and the Street Commissioner be authorized to secure automobile notice signs and place them. Upon motion it was carried. Upon motion the motion as amended was carried. Upon motion of Mr. Painter seconded by Mr. Donges the tax for General Borough purposes j and hereby is laid, assessed and fixed at the rate of three and one-half mills on the dollar, on the property taxable for General Borough purposes. A call for the yeas and nays was made. The vote follows: Jno. A. Donges - yea; Jos. M. Painter - yea; M. C. Haak - nay; Jas. Kalbach - yea; I. B. Haak - nay; H. L. Corl - yea. The motion was carried.

Orders drawn - Geo. D. Coover \$3.50 Ira K. Dutweiler, 6.65 total \$10.15. Upon motion it was decided to meet on May 17 at 8:00 P.M.
